In addition to being available in CD format, the new curriculum may also be accessed via the Department's website at www.education.ie. It has therefore been decided, that with immediate effect, printed copies of the curriculum will no longer be made available free of charge but will be available for purchase directly from the Government Publications Sale Office or by mail order from Government Publications, Mail Order Section (please see addresses above) at a cost of €70.00 per full set and €3.20 per single book.
