## Revision of Pay for Caretakers due under Sustaining Progress - June 2006 - TRBDI

I refer to the application in the education sector of a pay increase of 2.5% under Section 14.2 of the Mid-Term Review of Part Two of Sustaining Progress – Pay and the Workplace, with effect from 1 June 2006. Sanction is hereby conveyed for the implementation of the attached revised salary scales for grades of staff employed in TRBDI.

The payment of the increase is dependent on verification of co-operation with flexibility and ongoing change, satisfactory implementation of the agenda for modernisation, maintenance of stable industrial relations and absence of industrial action in respect of any matters covered by the Sustaining Progress Agreement. The Education Sector Performance Verification Group in consultation with the Secretary General of this Department has approved the Progress Report submitted and recommended payment of the 2½% increase due with effect from 1st June 2006.

Sanction is conveyed for the application of these increases to the pensions of retired staff on the same basis.
