Teacher Recruitment Policies at Post Primary Level.

As outlined in previous Circular Letters the Minister of Education and Science directed by <u>Circular 0101/2006</u> Circular 0102/2006 and <u>Circular 0103/2006</u> that school authorities and Vocational Education Committees ensure that their individual schools' policy on teacher recruitment have been revised, as appropriate in each sector, by reference to:

Section 7 A (b) of the Articles of Management of Community and Comprehensive schools

The requirements of Memo V7 and

Amended rule 1(4) of the Rules for the payment of Secondary Teachers,

and that:

A candidate proposed for appointment to their teaching staff shall be registered in accordance with section 31 of the Teaching Council Act, 2001.

Each candidate for appointment to a teaching post shall have qualifications, including teacher education, suited to the purpose of the post for which s/he is proposed.

Any offer of employment must be conditional on:-

a. the production of a current Registration Certificate or confirmation of registration from the Teaching Council of Ireland¹

and

b. the teacher being compliant with all other requirements of appointment in relation to probation and medical fitness etc.

The vetting of teaching staff shall be in accordance the terms of <u>Circular 0094/2006</u> and the Teaching Council cannot issue a certified statement of registration until the vetting process is complete.
