

## Circular Letter 0048/2010

To: BOARDS OF MANAGEMENT OF PRIMARY SCHOOLS

## Substitute cover for registered teachers employed in primary schools Arrangements for the 2010/2011 School Year.

- 1. The review of supervision and substitution and related matters commenced following the October 2008 Budget announcement in relation to supervision and substitution and the subsequent circulars issuing in this regard.
- 2. The interim outcome of the review provides that the substitution cover arrangements introduced in January 2009 for primary schools will continue for the 2010/2011school year.
- 3. Under these arrangements substitute cover is not provided for the first day of an absence of a teacher on uncertified sick leave in a school.
- 4. There are two exceptions to this general rule. The first is that substitute cover will be provided for the first day of an absence of a teacher on uncertified sick leave in schools with two or less classroom teachers.
- 5. The second is that in the event that two or more teachers in a school are absent from teaching duty on the first day of uncertified sick leave, substitute cover is provided for the second and subsequent teachers that are absent.

## Substitution Cover for Other Absences.

6. The existing arrangements for substitute cover for other absences of teachers from teaching duty will continue to apply.
