To: Director of each Institute of Technology and President, Dublin Institute of Technology.

Notice to Employers regarding a Further Extension to the 'Grace Period' for Superannuation Benefits for employees who are members of a public service pension scheme

- 1. I am directed by the Minister for Education and Skills to refer to Circular 0030/2013 and specifically to Paragraph 6.1 which states that a staff member who retires on or before the 31<sup>st</sup> August 2014 will have his or her superannuation benefits calculated by reference to the pay scales applying on the 30<sup>th</sup> June 2013. This 'Grace Period' was subsequently extended to the 30<sup>th</sup> June 2015 in Circular 0034/2014.
- 2. The Government has now decided to further extend the 'Grace Period' and consequently a staff member, who is a member of a public service pension scheme, and who retires on or before the 30<sup>th</sup> June 2016 will have his or her superannuation benefits calculated by reference to the pay scales applying on the 30<sup>th</sup> June 2013.
- 3. Please note that this circular letter supersedes Circular 0034/2014.

You are requested to bring the contents of this Circular to the attention of all staff in your Institute, including those on leave of absence.
