To: The Managerial Authorities of Recognised Primary, Secondary, Community and Comprehensive Schools and the Chief Executives of Education and Training Boards

Further Extension to the 'Grace Period' for Superannuation Benefits in respect of Teachers

- I am directed by the Minister for Education and Skills to refer to Circular 32/2013 (primary teachers) and Circulars 0005/2014 and 0006/2014 (post-primary teachers) which state that a teacher who retires on or before 31 August 2014 will have his or her superannuation benefits calculated by reference to the pay scales and pensionable allowances applying to him/her on 30 June 2013. This 'Grace Period' was subsequently extended to 30 June 2016 in Circular 0014/2015.
- The Government has now decided to further extend the 'Grace Period' and consequently
 a teacher who retires on or before 1 April 2019 will have his or her superannuation benefits
 calculated by reference to the pay scales and pensionable allowances applying to him/her
 on 30 June 2013.
- 3. Please note that this circular letter supersedes Circular 0014/2015.
- 4. Please ensure that copies of this Circular are provided to all members of the Board of Management/ Education and Training Board and its contents are brought to the attention of all teachers in your employment including those on approved paid or unpaid leave.
