**Circular 8/1946:- Uniform and Protective Clothing**

A Dhuine Uasail,

I am directed by the Minister for Finance to inform you that arrangements have been made whereby the Controller of Stores, Department of Posts and Telegraphs, will deal, in accordance with approved arrangements in force from time to time, with questions of the issue of protective clothing for civilian employees in government Departments. Accordingly, requisitions for the provision of such clothing should be furnished in future direct to the Controller of Stores, without prior reference to the Department of Finance for sanction.

The existing practice under which prior Finance sanction is required for initial issues of uniforms to civilian staffs, other than Messengers and Attendants covered by Finance Circular No.5/33, will continue to apply.
