Circular 21/1963:- Reduction in the Conditioned Hours of Work of General Service Messengers

A Dhuine Uasail,

I am directed by the Minister for Finance to inform you that he has accepted an agreed recommendation made by the General Council (Report No, 316) under the scheme of conciliation and arbitration for the Civil Service for the application of revised conditioned weekly hours of work to general service Messengers.

I am, accordingly, to convey the Minister's authority for a reduction in the conditioned weekly hours of work of general service Messengers from 48 hours, gross, to 44 hours gross, with effect as from 12 September, 1963. Overtime payments to general service Messengers will commence after completion of 44 hours, gross, instead of 48 hours, gross, as hitherto, and will be calculated at a rate based on a 44 hour working week.
