Circular 7/1966:- Reduction in the Conditioned Hours of Work of General Service Cleaners (Men)

A Dhuine Uasail,

I am directed by the Minister for Finance to inform you that he has accepted an agreed recommendation made by the General Council (Report No. 385) under the scheme of conciliation and arbitration for the Civil Service for the application of revised conditioned weekly hours of work to general service Cleaners (Men).

I am, accordingly, to convey the Minister's authority for a reduction in the conditioned weekly hours of work of general Service Cleaners (Men) from 48 hours, gross, to 44 hours gross, with effect as from 25 March, 1966. Over- time payments to general service Cleaners (Men) will commence after completion of 44 hours, gross, instead of 48 hours, gross, as hitherto, and will be calculated at a rate based on a 44 hour working week.
