Circular 41/1971:- Reduction in the conditioned Hours of Work of the general. service grades of Staff Officer, Executive Officer and Higher Executive Officer

## A Dhuine Uasail

I am directed by the Minister for Finance to state that he has accepted an agreed recommendation made by the General Council under the scheme of conciliation and arbitration for the Civil Service for the application of revised conditioned weekly hours of work to the general service grades of Staff Officer, Executive Officer and Higher Executive Officer.

2. I am, accordingly, to convey the Minister's authority for a reduction in the conditioned weekly hours of work of these grades from 42 (gross) to 41 (gross) with effect from 4 October 1971. In relation to the grade of Staff Officer (general service) overtime payments will, with effect from 4 October 1971, commence after completion of 41 hours (gross), instead of 42 hours (gross), and will be calculated on the basis of a 41-hour working week.
