## Circular 22/1972:- Reduction in the conditioned hours of work of the grade of Sightless Telephonist

I am directed by the Minister for Finance to state that he has accepted an agreed recommendation made by the General Council, under the conciliation and arbitration scheme for the civil service, for the application of revised conditioned weekly hours of work to the grade of Sightless Telephonist.

I am, accordingly, to convey the Minister's authority for a reduction in the conditioned weekly hours of work of the grade of Sightless Telephonist from 42 (gross) to 41 (gross) with effect from 5 June 1972. Overtime payments to this grade will, therefore, with effect from 5 June 1972, commence after completion of 41 hours (gross) and will be calculated on the basis of a 41-hour working week.
