Circular 26/2007: Production of Statutory Instruments

A Dhuine Uasail

- 1. I am directed by the Minister for Finance to refer to this Department's circular 4/59, regarding the printing and publication of statutory instruments, and to state that the Instructions accompanying that circular, as subsequently amended, are hereby withdrawn and replaced by the **Guidelines on Electronic Statutory Instruments** prepared by the Working Group on Electronic Statutory Instruments.
- 2. The Guidelines which can be found on the Better Regulation website at <u>www.betterregulation.ie</u> describe the electronic Statutory Instrument System, which was approved by the Government in Decision S260/15/35/0093A of 20 June 2007.
- 3. The main feature of the new system is that a Statutory Instrument must be converted into the required format for placing on websites and for printing **before** it can be signed by the relevant Minister or Authorised Officer.
- 4. When a Statutory Instrument is signed by the Minister it should be published in the PDF format on the public body's website as soon as possible after signature.
- 5. This circular and the associated guidelines should be brought to the attention of all relevant staff.
