Re: Travelling Expenses/ Motor Travel Rates

I wish to advise you that approval may be assumed for implementation of the revised rates for travelling expenses with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2005.

The revised rates are shown in mile and kilometre format below. These rates will, in future, be referred to as motor travel rates. Payment of the rates authorised in this circular is subject to the general regulations governing such payment and any other instructions which in force from time to time.
