1. The claim was that a competition for visually impaired Computer Programmers be held, confined to visually impaired civil servants.

2. The Staff Side in seeking a confined competition for appointment as visually impaired Computer Programmer referred to a previous confined competition for Computer Programmer agreed in General Council Report 1076 in 1986.

3. The Official Side said that they would be agreeable to the holding of an open competition for visually impaired Computer Programmer. Civil servants, provided that they fulfilled any eligibility requirements set out for the competition, would be eligible to apply .

4. Following discussion it was agreed to recommend that an open competition for appointment as visually impaired Computer Programmer be held by the Civil Service Commission.
