Claim: to review of Flexible Working Hours Agreement to provide for an 8 a.m. start and a 7.30 p.m. finish and also an arrangement whereby staff can work up to 14 extra hours to enable them to avail of 2 day flexi leave

(Meeting/s of 6 February 2001, 6 March, 2001, 28 March, 2001)

1. It is agreed that the question of commencing the morning flexible band at 8.00 a.m. and ending the evening flexible band at 7.00 p.m. may be introduced in Departments or Offices following discussions at Departmental Councils.
2. Such discussions at Departmental Councils will address any management concerns about the delivery of customer services and supervision of staff in the context of the extended hours.
3. In this connection, it is agreed that the extension of the flexible bands will not, of itself, justify an increase in the credit carry over of 11.5 hours provided for in General Council Report No.1302 and the current claim for increased carry over will not be pursued.
4. This report records such agreement.
