

Civil Service Conciliation and Arbitration Scheme

General Council Report 1478

(Meeting/s of 8 November 2006)

Application of the terms of Towards 2016, Ten-Year Framework Social Partnership Agreement 2016-2015 to civil servants within the Conciliation and Arbitration Scheme.

1. The Staff Side referred to the ratification by the Irish Congress of Trade Unions of Towards 2016, Ten-Year Framework Social Partnership Agreement 2006-2015 including the agreed provisions on Public Service Pay and related issues, which form part of it. They were now seeking the application of the terms of the Agreement to all civil servants comprehended by the Conciliation and Arbitration Scheme, with the exception of the grades represented by the Civil, Public and Services Union which is not in a position to agree pending a ballot of its members.
2. The Official Side said that they were agreeable that the Agreement, including the provisions in regard to delivering quality public services, should be applied in the case of civil servants comprehended by the Conciliation and Arbitration Scheme.
3. The Staff Side said they were prepared to accept this offer.
