<u>Claim seeking an 'urban weighing allowance' for staff working in urban</u> areas

- 1. The Staff Side put forward this claim on the basis that there are additional costs associated with living in urban areas and sought an allowance for this.
- 2. The Official Side responded that
- This is clearly a major cost increasing claim and is precluded by the terms of T2016.
- It would have major implications for the common pay system across Departments and for decentralisation.
- There is no evidence of recruitment or turnover difficulties in Dublin or other urban areas.
- Allowance would be at variance with private sector norms and policy is that public sector pay should not lead private sector pay.
- A similar claim in respect of nurses was not accepted by the Benchmarking Body.
- 3. The Official Side refused to concede the claim.
- 4. This report recording disagreement was adopted on 25 June 2008.
