I enclose a copy of General Council Report No. 1435 regarding special payments in respect of consistent and exceptional extra attendance by non-overtime grades arising from the Irish Presidency of the European Union in 2004.

This letter conveys sanction for the implementation of the arrangements set out in the General Council Report. The basis on which payments should be considered is set out in Paragraph 5 of the Report. As indicated in paragraph 5, it will be a matter for the Head of a Department to assess the appropriate level of payment within the ranges specified. Payments should be dealt with out of the 0.2% provision in the administrative budgets for exceptional performance and, as an exceptional matter, the normal provision can be exceeded in 2004, if necessary, within the overall administrative budget allocation.

The Official Side has also agreed to increase the delegate's and chairperson's allowance with effect from 1 January 2004 (inclusive of the general increase of 3% under Sustaining Progress).
