

Civil Service Conciliation and Arbitration Scheme

General Council Report 1248

(Meeting/s of 24 February 1993, 28 April 1993)

Claim that the annual leave allowance of Lab. Technicians in the Civil Service be 24 days w.e. from a current date.

Claim for an increase in the annual leave allowance of Laboratory Technician

1. The claim is for a revised annual leave allowance of 21 days rising to 24 days after five years service for the grade of Laboratory Technician.
2. The Staff Side said that the leave allowance claimed was justified by reference to the leave currently available in grades with comparable salary scales.
3. Following discussion, in which account was taken of developments in relation to the salaries of the relevant grades, it was agreed to recommend that the annual leave allowance for the grade of Laboratory Technician should be 21 days rising to 24 days after five years service, the revised allowance to apply with effect from the current leave year.
