**15/01/1993 LP:- Annual Leave allowance for certain grades represented by the Federated Union of Government Employees**

Dear Personnel Officer

I am directed by the Minister for Finance to say that he has accepted an agreed recommendation made by the General Council under the scheme of conciliation and arbitration for the civil service on a claim for the revision of the annual leave allowances appropriate to grades represented by the Federated Union of Government Employees (General Council Report 1212 refers) .

Accordingly, with effect from the 1990/91 leave year, the annual leave allowances appropriate to the following grades are:

Head Messenger        19 days

Warehouseman        18 days, rising to 19 days after 5 years' service

Laboratory Attendant 18 days, rising to 19 days after 5 years' service

Storekeeper            18 days, rising to 19 days after 5 years' service

(Department of the Marine and State Laboratory only)

It should be noted that, in accordance with paragraph 8 of Circular 26/85, prior pensionable service given in a grade with a leave allowance of 18 days is reckonable for the progression, where relevant under paragraph 2 above, to 19 days.
